# BIBLE STUDY THEME: KINGDOM GROWTH BY EVANGELISM AND DISCIPLESHIP

**LESSON:** Christ in Discipleship Part 2 – Scripture: Matthew 16:21-28

June 29, 2021

What is clear from this Scripture, is <u>obedience and submission to Christ</u> is central to being his disciple.

#### Obedience to God:

- 1. Proves our love for Him (1 John 5:2-3)
- 2. Demonstrates our faithfulness to Him (1 John 2:3-6)
- 3. Glorifies Him in the world (1 Peter 2:12)
- 4. Opens avenues of blessing for us (John 13:17).

Jesus tells Peter that he must <u>remove his human concern and self-interest</u> in **favor** for the things that concern God.

As a result, a true disciple then <u>loses his own will</u> because the things of God take **priority** which leads to total surrendering to the will of God.

Obedience and submission <u>does not cause one to lose their own identity</u>, rather, it means <u>having a right and respectful relationship with God</u>.

#### ONE'S IDENTITY IS NOW IN CHRIST – Galatians 2:20

Obedience is an attitude of the heart that enables the follower to be submissive and open to others. It is about obeying and following all of Jesus' commands to go and make disciples. To do this however, the follower of Christ must be willing to help others to get to know him.

To drive this point home, before one can be a disciple, obedience to all of Jesus' commands must be followed, after all, one cannot teach another to be a disciple of Christ without first being a disciple of Christ.

A disciple is a learner who seeks to follow the ways of his teacher or master. "God demands absolute obedience to His commands."

Following Jesus will be **overwhelming**, but it is **imperative to follow**:

- 1) <u>Great Commandment</u>: love God with everything you have and love your neighbor as much as you love yourself (Matt 22:7-40)
- 2) **New Commandment**: love one another (John 13:34-35)
- 3) **Great Commission**: make disciples who make disciples.

## I. Three Stages of Discipleship

- 1) Declaration
- 2) Development
- 3) Deployment

**Declaration - investigation leading to repentance and faith** in Jesus. (See John 1:35-2:12)

**Development** - (immersion, abandonment and apprenticeship into ministry) is about **continuing to grow in Christ.** 

**Deployment** - (intentional global commissioning), is about going and serving through the Great Commission.

<u>To multiply and make future disciples</u>, one must first be a disciple of Christ exhibiting obedience by taking Christ at his word and follow him in making discipleship.
